JCSS came into existence in the year 1985 and was registered in the same year under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860. It was the time when the people of Uttar Pradesh (U.P.) were facing the onslaught of severe drought. The prime task of the organization was to release the people from the cruel clutches of drought and its subsequent hunger and thirst. JCSS thus took the initiative to help the victims of drought through various development projects related to agriculture and irrigation. It has been serving the people of Bundelkhand region of UP for the last 34 years with the dignty.


The Catholic Diocese of Jhansi comprises of seven districts in U. P. namely, Jhansi, Lalitpur, Jalaun, Banda, Mahoba, Hamirpur and Chitrakoot. JCSS has to its credit 34 years of commitment to animation programmes, covering 554 villages with different projects to capacitate and develop the people of the target area. It has succeeded in bringing attitudinal and behavioural changes among the villagers through self-help, awareness programmes, training, seminars and workshops.

JCSS cares where no one dares. It has reached remotest villages in the middle of the forest of Madawara Block, Lalitpur and Manikpur Block, Chitrakoot where Sahariya, Gode and Koll tribes dwell. JCSS is striving to impart education to their less-privileged children, helping these tribes to sustain their livelihood, providing them with their basic needs of food, clothes and shelter through community development programmes and enabling them to demand for their basic needs and rights from the Government.

The activities that are undertaken by the organization mainly focused on livelihood promotion through sustainable agriculture development and income generation activities to improve the economic condition of the people of the target area. We collaborate with government departments in our new initiatives to facilitate the target people to draw benefits from the government schemes especially livelihood schemes of the state and the central governments. These new programmes are mainly focusing on women, families living below the poverty line, persons with disabilities, minorities, scheduled castes andother backward classes.

We cannot always build the future for our young ones, but we can build the young ones for our future.

We consider and understand empowerment of children and youth is highly required for the development in our nation. But the situation of Uttar Pradesh is pathetic and it is home to 8.5 crore children and one in every five girls here is a child bride, according to Government of India's National Family Health Survey. Apart from child marriage we can see illiteracy, rape, child labour etc.

So we are addressing such evils through vocational training programs conducting as part of our various projects to make them self- reliant. Our team ensuring the availability of the opportunities to maximum interested targets and conducting various streams by foreseeing the demand in future as well as the interest of the targets. For girls we are conducting tailoring and beautician courses and for boys, diesel engine repair, motor winding etc.

Apart from these trainings, we also providing various kinds of awareness also for them with the support of knowledgeable persons as well as observing the special days of them like Youth Day, Children's Day, Kishori Divas and providing opportunities to them to organize events.

As we all know, this year India remained as normal, as we consider, only for three months. At end of March onwards India wore mask on it mouth, hold sanitizers in hands and started staying at home; yeah, then we started our new normal phase; the COVID Phase!!!

The first few days as everyone, we also decided to stay inside for the good of all of us. But it continued only for very few days. Because of the incidents occurs in those days such as; migration of people, unavailability of food and water, unemployment etc. we considered these as a call for us to back to field for serve the needy, as well as it was an eye opener for us to realize that, lockdown is not a good thing for every one and there are people who least bothered about the pandemic because of the unpleasant realities of life.

We had broken the shield of safe cocoon on 23rd March 2020 and wore the shield of warriors against COVID 19 and started to render our service within our boundaries. We requested to the authorities and pursued the permission to work as Relief Volunteers.

Our Community Kitchen fed 1,98,685 people, our Grocery Kit lit the stoves of 6952 people and we reached up to 4000 people as shields of protection and provided masks, sanitizers and hygiene kits. Here we gladly remembering all kind hearted people, who supported us for the relief work, our district authority for the timely guidance and support and last but not least; our volunteers, who spent their time for satisfy our wish with gratitude.

DESIRE DECIDES

Here we initiated to switch our actions in a more practical way; we recommence our projects activities by obeying the regulations set by the government along with the relief works. We believe in the ideology that social work is nothing, but teaching someone in need to 'how to catch fish'.

We desired and decided to recommence all the projects and resumed on 6th June 2020. We always provided preference to the safety of our staffs and beneficiaries; conducted all the actions timely and realized that, everything is possible even in a worse situation, if we have an optimistic attitude and obedience as habit.

STRENGTH TO LIVE WITH CORONA

The actuality may sometimes really difficult to accept but as social beings we have to and should find the ways to overcome the challenges. The very first thing we have done after the lockdown was organized awareness sessions to our beneficiaries to overcome the fear that they made inside their mind about COVID and the required changes that have to adopt to their lifestyle to live with the Corona Scenario. We exhibited printed materials in public places distributed hygiene kits to the needy. As part of adding strength to the life of needy we have organized an income generation program Earn at Crisis, the beneficiaries of our project themselves prepared posters and pasted on public walls.

EARN @ CRISIS

We gradually stopped the distribution of food soon after the lock down because our resources were limited to continue unsustainable actions which will not support the beneficiaries in future. Then we initiated a program named Earn at Crisis. As part of it we supported 69 individuals to setup income generation startups. As a result of the program the mentioned 69 individuals blessed to start their own petty shops, ladies stores, egg shops, goatry, poultry etc







Agriculture is our wisest pursuit, because it will in the end contribute most to real wealth, good morals and happiness. So it is our responsibility to work for land and growth of farmers. Through our agriculture projects which operating in Talbehat, Bangra and Mahua blocks of Lalitpur, Jhansi and Banda Districts respectively had done some beneficial acts for the one who works to feed all.

The activities and achievements done for them is as follows:

- 7 Farmers Clubs formed and linked with the banks as well as 18 Self Help Groups also formed and linked with banks and NRLM.
- P Developed 183 kitchen garden in 16 project villages.
- 556 farmers from 16 villages done soil test.



- ↑ 240 farmers were benefitted from training on organic manure, growth promoters and pest management.
- Constructed 2000 trenches for ground water recharge.
- ↑ 260 farmers were benefitted from the training on PRI, roles and responsibilities with respect to ensuring access to rights of the community.



- Placed 8 Suggestion boxes in various target areas to support the beneficiary's appropriately.
- Organized 8 training programs on government schemes related to livelihood and food security; 295 farmers were benefitted from the same.
- Poeveloped 4 IEC materials on Organic Agriculture, preparation of Nadev Compost, Vermi Compost and Matka Khad.
- 📍 50 farmers from Mahua and Badokhor Block benefitted from smokeless chulas.
- PEstablished one solar lift irrigation system in Madhopur village and 15 farmers benefitted from it.



- Provided 20 seed banks to 20 targeted farmer's clubs in Bangra for the preservation of seeds.
- Organized technical support program on organic farming to the targeted farmers of Bangra to improve their methods. PGSS, Gorakhpur provided the technical support to us.

- Supported 17 children by the facility of transportation for medical assistance.

THE PROMISES OF TOMORROW

The quality and personality of children and youth will determine the kind of destiny of nation. Therefore it is mandatory to build them in a strong, healthy and intellectual way. They have abundant energy that is tempted to flow in many ways; here we can act as a mold and channelize their energy in a fruitful way for the development and growth of the nation.

We know it is impossible to work for the welfare of all children and youth; but it is possible to work for the welfare of at least some and through them we can establish our vision. So we decided to work for the empowerment of children and youth through our projects. The steps that we have taken for them is given below.

- Provided awareness on the important of education to children, youth as well as to their parents.
- Organized career guidance in 15 villages and around 200 individuals were benefitted from it.
- ♥ 150 individuals were benefitted from Life Skill training and Leadership Development.
- Provided leadership development training to 230 individuals.
- Organized training on health and hygiene to 150 individuals.
- The children and youth from 15 targeted villages self-motivated and observed a week as Swachhta Abhiyan.
- The members of children parliament prepared posters on COVID 19 and exhibited to generate public awareness.
- Arranged the provision of vocational training for the interested girls and boys according to their interest. The main courses are beautician, tailoring, computer and diesel engine repair.

I am Janki belongs to Ranipur village of Manikpur Block, Chitrakoot District. I was one among those girls who still secretly wishes to stand up by themselves and support the family by their own contribution. But in villages like mine, there were no opportunity for children especially for girls to work to achieve their ambitions. Even the parents restricted to go to schools.




So girls like me ourselves trained to bury the dreams inside our mind and goes with flows of life. But the launching of tailoring center in our village as part of SHAKTI Project was changed the custom followed by the people in our village The staffs of the project motivated the girls like me and our parents about the importance of vocational skill training and build a path for girls like us to stand up on our foot.

I enrolled for tailoring course of 2 months and successfully completed. Now I have my own sewing machine and I started a Tailoring Shop in my home. Through this I learned one important lesson for life that is; if you are a self-sustain person then obviously you will get the courage to be in your own point of view and others will respect your words as well.

* Education is Power

My name is Anjali Giri from Sengua Village of Gurusarai Block in Jhansi District. My father is a daily waged worker and my mother is a house wife. I have two sisters and one brother. The thinking pattern of my parents was also like majority of the parents in Uttar Pradesh. They were least bothered about the



education of girl child and provided more importance to their marriage and other aspects. I am very much interested in my studies from my young age but after the completion of 8th standard my parents denied me from going school. I felt really sad and I begged them for the permission to go for studies. But nothing happens.

In 2017 staffs of Jhansi Catholic Seva Samaj came into our village and launched a project named SAKHI and encouraged girls like me to join in their group. In initial stage I was so confused to join the group but each group activities made me stronger and from the staffs I happened to learn a lot of life lessons. As part of home visit the staffs of SAKHI visited my home and met my parents also. They motivated my parents and made them aware about the importance of education.

Finally the staffs succeeded in their task of making understand my parents and they allowed me to resume my studies. Now I am studying to pursuing my dreams. I will be ever thankful to team SAKHI and JCSS for reconstructed the way towards my dreams.

*Into Agriculture

I am a small scale farmer belongs to Madhopur Village of Mahua Block of Banda District. My name is Ramesh. The one and only livelihood option of my family is our land and agriculture. Our happiness and sadness depends on the growth of the crops. This is not only the story of mine but also the story of almost every individuals in my village.



Lack of irrigation facility was one of the biggest problems faced by us but the sarcasm is that we have plenty of water under our land. Due to the financial deficiency none of us were not able to go for a bore well or any other means. So we were depends on the bore well of other people who have bore well to cater our needs. But it became very expensive during the period of summer and it will lead us to economic crisis also.

Now as part of project ViSTAR, Jhansi Catholic Seva Samaj fixed a solar lift irrigation system in my land and afterwards we no more face any issues related to water. Me and my neighbor land holders utilizing the facility of the solar lift irrigation system. For us it is a great support and relief because agriculture is something divine for us.

*Believe in Miracles



The agriculture is just like an art for farmers like us but sometimes nature will examine you with unexpected things like unseasonal heavy rainfall or less rainfall etc. and it will totally destroy the cultivation and financial crisis will takes place. It happens many times and I became fed up and hopeless. I was not ignorant about the wide facilities providing by the government for the welfare of farmers also. I believe in miracles of God because when my situation went wrong the same time staffs of JCSS approached

me and explained about project SAKSHAM launching for the welfare of farmers and farmers like me joined to their farmers clubs and attended the meetings and awareness sessions done by them

Later I discussed my problem with them and they helped me to network with agriculture department at block level; where I got opportunity to meet Dr. Sbita Koushik and share my problems. She suggested me to adopt a mixed cropping and informed me with some crops best to cultivate together.

Today I am practicing mixed crop cultivation in my land and it will take 6 months for harvest. It is profitable for me and now I am suggesting the same to many who have facing the same crisis. I believe that my life changed because of the right time intercourse with SAKSHAM staffs. Now I am seeking expert advices before going for cultivation and the positive side of it is visible in my field also.
